

Spring 2024 Class 3 – What are we learning this half term?

English

Class Text

The Hobbit by J.R.R. Tolkien

- Writing genres Dialogue, narrative, persuasive writing.
- Punctuation and grammar work classes, sentence types and the use of the colon and semi-colon to separate clauses
- Spelling focus -tion, -ture, -ibly, -ably, anti-, inter-, -tial, -cial and homophones.

Maths

The maths content we will be covering this term will be:

- Multiplication and division (Year 4/5)
 - Length & perimeter (all)
 - Fractions & decimals (all)
 - Algebra (Year 6)

Science

In science, we are still looking at *Animals Including Humans* where the children will be learning about:

- The circulatory system and the effect of exercise on the heart.
 - Birth to old age.

The children will think about what their ambitions are for the future in regards to out of school activities and in school aspects of their lives.

RE

What is it like for a Muslim Living in Britain?

The children will learn about aspects of a Muslim's life whilst living in Britain, including prayer, places of worship and celebrations.

History

Why was Pompeii built near a volcano?

The class will be looking at a range of volcanoes from around the world, with the focus being Vesuvius in Italy. Throughout the unit, children will learn about how volcanoes are created and their impact on the human and physical world. The children will also learn about Italian agriculture, trade and land use.

Homework

Homework handed out on Fridays and expected back in school on the following Thursday. It will consist of spelling, reading & comprehension, maths and research study (but not all on the same week!)

Internet Safety and Networks

This term the children will use the Purple Mash program of study to:

French

The Weather & French Customs
