### Maths

This term we will cover the following units of work- To 20 and beyond, How many now?, Manipulate, Compose and Decompose. Exploring 3d shape. Number bonds to 10.

### Understanding the World

We are going to be learning about the importance of bees. We will be planting wildflowers, garden plants and sunflowers. These flowers promote the conservation of bees in our local environment.

### Computing

In computing we will be using the computer software to draw what we can see in nature. Our drawings will be inspired by the artist Jackson Pollock to see if we can re- create his art by using technology.

### English

Our writing this term will include writing about how to look after chicks in preparation for the chicks arriving in class 1. We will be reading the traditional tale Jack and the Beanstalk and writing about the characters in the story and deciding if they are good or bad characters.

### Theme

#### Let it Grow

We have a very exciting term ahead. We will be learning about how to look after chicks with the arrival of some chicken eggs early in the term. We will be learning about the life cycles of chickens, plants and other animals.

### PSED

Children will be learning about how to make friends, resolve conflicts, helping others to feel part of a group, showing respect in how they treat others and know how to help others when they feel hurt or upset.

### Physical Education

This term we will be discovering how many ways we can throw a ball? Can we throw underarm or overarm? . We will be also looking at how we stop a ball from going past us and how we can catch a ball.

### Music

This term we will be exploring sea themed soundscapes, composing new lyrics and responding to music with instruments. Later in the term we will be getting creative with the song 'It's oh so quiet ' by Bjork and using dynamics for creative effect .

### At home

We will be consolidating our phonics learning this term. We will be practicing all the single letter sounds (phase 2) and digraphs (phase 3) we have learnt all year. We will be thinking about our favourite stories and sharing them at home.
