Maths

This term we will cover the following units of work-

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division
- Measures

Science

Animals including humans

In this unit, pupils will understand what is means to be a human and animal with the essential parts and their functions. They will investigate what animals and humans need to survive.

Computing

Internet safety

We will recap prior learning and expand on this to cover communicating online, avoiding Malware and general internet safety. Children will take part in a series of games interactive workshops to understand what it means to be safe online.

English

Foundation subject focus, History

Great Fire of London

We will begin by exploring the events that transpired that led to the catastrophe known as the Great Fire of London. Children will look at a range of historical sources to create a picture of life in London 1666. This will be Geography/ DT in the spring term and The Arts in the summer term.

Physical Education

Mental well-being

Tony Chestnut/ Carnival of Animal

This term, we will be focusing on the children understanding beat, rhythm, melody, echo, calland-response, tuned and untuned music using Tony Chestnut songs. Before progressing onto focusing on timbre, tempo, dynamics, pitch, classical music. Pieces: Carnival of the animals by Camille Saint-Saëns.
