A reminder, that for families with children due to start Reception at Burton Salmon in September 2021 and for any families looking for a Nursery place, we are holding an Open Week for you to be able to come and have a socially-distanced look at what we have to offer – especially after our fantastic Class 1 refurbishment last year! **Open Week will start the first week back after half-term on Monday 2nd November until Friday 6th November with pre-bookable appointments, via the school office, from 9.30am, 10.30am, 11.30am, 1.30pm and 2.30pm daily.** If you are unable to make these times throughout the day, please contact school to arrange an appointment at either 3.30pm or 4.30pm. We ask that that just one adult comes along (face mask necessary) with your child to get a taste of what Burton Salmon school life is like! Our other federated schools Open Weeks are as follows: Barlow Primary School's Open Week will be from Monday 2nd November and Chapel Haddlesey Primary School's Open Week starts on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November.

### Flu Vaccinations

The Childhood Immunisation Team have contacted school to advise that they will be in school next half-term (**on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> November**) to vaccinate all of the children in every year group whose parents or carers have completed the online consent form. Please see below for details of how to consent for your child

How do I give my consent?

1. Go to <https://www.hdft.nhs.uk/fluconsent>
2. Enter the School Code 121385 and click "Find School".
3. Complete the form with your child's information and parent/guardian contact information.
4. Click the green "Submit" button.

The **deadline to give consent is by the 25th October** and **ONLY** children whose parents have given consent online, will be immunised.



**Parents/Carers of Year 6 pupils** – please note that you will need to apply online for secondary school places by Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020. This date falls over half-term, so this is the last opportunity for school to remind you of the deadline.

### Housekeeping



**Pupil absences:** it is really important that you please make sure you telephone or email the school before 9.15am to notify us of any child absence, with a reason for their absence. Equally, we ask if your child is unwell and you have called on the first day of their absence, we also require a call on each subsequent day until they are well enough to be back in school. If we don't receive any communication, by phone or email, we start our process of contacting all of the contacts allocated to your child and if we still haven't received any information, the Children Missing in Education protocol is triggered. Thank you for your cooperation with this.



**Parking** – We are still having to address parking concerns around school. Please be considerate when parking outside school and around the village; avoiding the traffic cones which are placed along the main road outside of the school. We also request that you avoid parking on the sharp bend, yellow lines, neighbouring driveways, the yellow school zigzags (including dropping off and waiting) and please turn off your engine whilst you are parked and waiting in your car. Thank you.

### OOSC – Pippins and Orchard Club drop-offs and collections



For the Pippins Breakfast Club, Mrs Wilson will open the main School Reception door at 8am. **Children must be brought to the door by an adult and handed over to her or another member of staff; please do not park on the road and allow your child to enter the school grounds by themselves.** And for the Orchard After-school club, in Class 1, please knock or ring and your children will be brought to the main school Reception door by Mrs Laycock, to be collected and signed out by Parents/Carers. Please note that this session finishes at 5.30pm. All payments are added to ParentPay.

**Orchard afternoon after-school club:** please could parents/carers indicate the approximate collection time for your child when booking a place. Also, if you could please inform school by 12noon if you are cancelling any pre-booked provision for that same day, otherwise you may incur a charge for that session. Thank you.

### Outstanding ParentPay debts



Please could parents and carers ensure that any outstanding ParentPay debts are cleared over half-term. Across the federation, there is an agreed maximum debt per child, which is £30.00. This includes any nursery fees, school dinners, trips, and out of school club payments.
