Maths

This term we will cover the following units of work-

Computing

Internet safety

We will recap prior learning and expand on this to cover communicating online, use of a search engine and understanding the digital footprint. They will progress onto confident use of the keyboard using a series of Purple Mash games.

English

The Most Famous Landmarks in the World: History and curiosities explained for children

Do you wish to expand your children's knowledge of famous global landmarks, inspire awe in them, give them some sense of place, destination, and wish them to learn these engineering marvels in a fun and exciting way that will leave them etched in their minds?

List creators, advertisers, journalists and story makers. Children will be using their knowledge of landmarks and their class novel to consolidate their geography knowledge.

RE

During this half term's RE we will be looking into the Jewish faith and what it means to be a Jew. We will look into traditions and religious stories and make links between other faiths. There will be a specific focus on prayers and how different faiths use them to help and support them through the good and bad times. We look at the process of prayer too and discuss why people decide to pray.

Science

We will be investigating everyday materials and why we use certain materials to do certain jobs. Why do we use wood to make chairs and not glass? Children will be creating their own hypothesis and testing it out. Children will also explore magnets and learning about other forces.

PSHE

This half term's topic is about Dreams and Goals. We will start by discussing what are own dreams and goals for the future are and how we can break that into smaller steps to achieve them. We will end by evaluating our own journey and see what we have learnt.

Physical Education

Dance is this half term's topic with a theme of Space! We will be taking on roles, moving with emotion and portraying scenarios which will then be built upon in the weeks to come. At the end of the half term, we will perform the whole routine to an audience.

Music

Grandma Rap

This term, we will be focusing on the pulse of music and how it can be used to convey emotion. Using the medium of the *Grandma Rap*, the children will be understanding what a jog and walk duration is. They will use this knowledge to create their own 4-beat pattern using the walk and jog durations.

Homework

Homework will be set on a weekly basis using homework books. The homework will be made up of English, Maths or topic-based work. We encourage children to read daily using their reading journals. Don't forget about Bug Club and TTRS as fun games for their reading and times tables.
