Dear Children and Parents,

Burton Salmon School Council have organised Christmas parties across the school to be held on Friday 20th December. Party wear may be brought into school in a named bag and the children will change into this after lunch. The children will be taking part in party games during the afternoon, so please ensure that appropriate footwear is worn.
